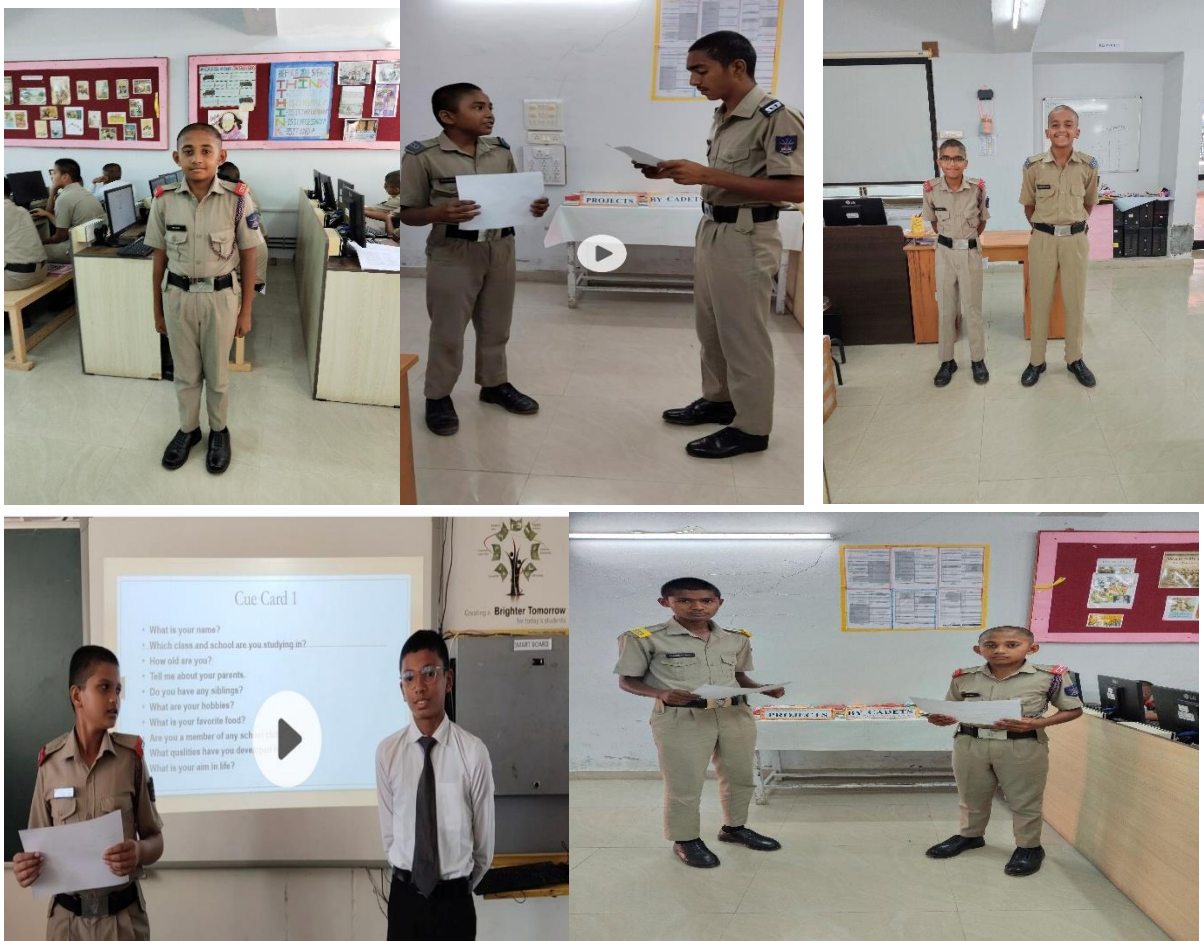
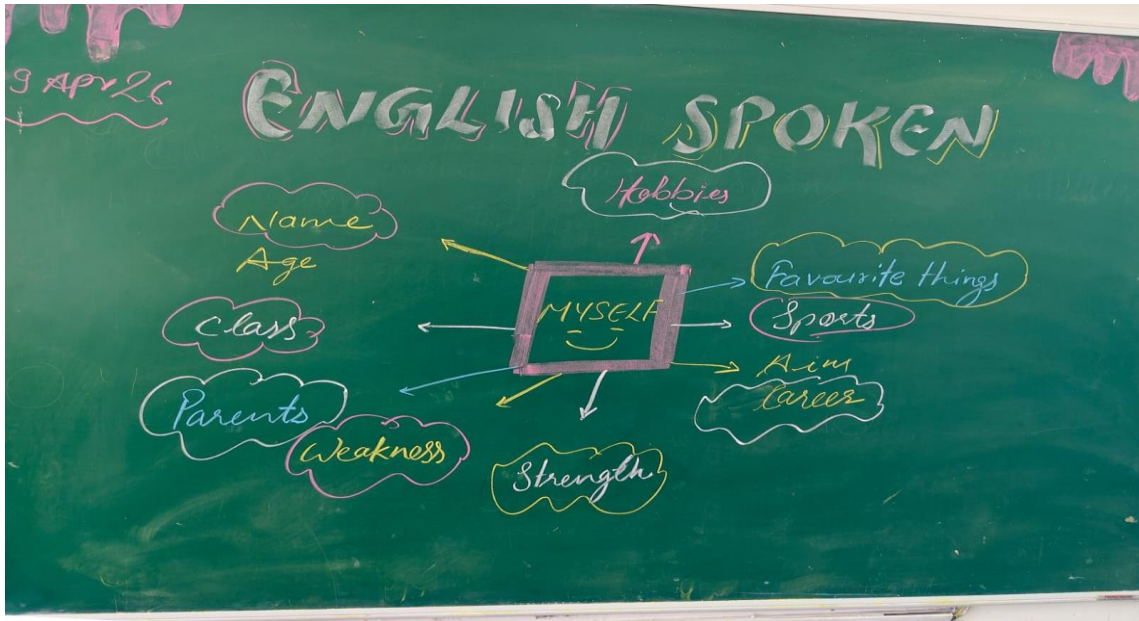


## Communicative English Classes – Class VIII (A, B & C)
